 - Attended five meetings of the IEEE COMSOC Board
 - Presented the minutes of the meeting to the TC
 - Summary
 - The Board approved P1901 PAR, "Broadband over Power Line Networks: Medium Access Control and Physical Layer Specifications"
 - The Board considered petitioning the IEEE SA to transfer the P1900 series projects (P1900.1 – 4) from SCC 41 to sponsorship by the Communications Society Standards Board
 - The Board considered the "Convergent Digital Home Network for Heterogeneous Technologies" to become P1901.5
 - The Board indicated that "the Smart Grid Vision document" will be developed by the Ad Hoc Committee (Stefano Galli and Byeong Gi Lee)
 - The expected first kick off meeting for this initiative was scheduled on October 7, 2010

- The TAB and IEEE SG executive committee are expected to support the initiative and IEEE SA has already committed to support this initiative
- Another initiative considered by the Board is the IEEE DYSPAN Status as a Standard
